HOW WAS THE MALAYSIAN MEDIATION CENTRE ("MMC") SET UP?

- A body established under the auspices of the Malaysian Bar Council
- In 1997, the Bar Council set up an Alternative Dispute Resolution Committee to look into the possibility of setting up an ADR Centre
- It was launched on 5th November 1999

MMC OBJECTIVES

- Promote Mediation
- Provide proper avenue for successful dispute resolution
- Provide Mediation training

MMC VENUES

- Main Centre
 - At the premises of the Malaysian Bar Council
- Other Centres
 - At the premises of the State Bar Committees

MMC SERVICES

- Offers a comprehensive range of services
- 1. Professional Mediation Services by trained Mediators, accredited and appointed to the Panel of Mediators of MMC
- 2. Provide assistance and advice on Mediation
- 3. Provide training in Mediation techniques
- 4. Provide Consultancy services in dispute management and conflict avoidance
- 5. Administrative and Secretarial Support

MALAYSIAN MEDIATION ACT 2012

- Promoted by MMC
- Drafted by MMC
- Approved by the Parliament's Draftsmen (subject to removal of certain provisions)
- Passed as an act by Malaysian Parliament in 2012
- The Act does not cover Court Annexed Mediation

COURT ANNEXED MEDIATION

- Practice Direction No. 5 of 2010
- Judges to encourage mediation in the following cases:
 - Personal Injury
 - Defamation
 - Matrimonial disputes
 - Commercial disputes
 - Contractual disputes
 - Intellectual property cases

COURT ANNEXED MEDIATION: Types

- 2 types
 - Judge Led
 - Mediator from MMC

COURT ANNEXED MEDIATION

- Practice Direction No. 4 of 2016
 - Revoked earlier Practice Direction
 - It brings in an additional mode of mediation i.e.
 - Judge Led
 - Mediation by Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre for Arbitration (KLRCA)
 - Mediation by MMC

EFFECT OF COURT ANNEXED MEDIATION ON MMC

- Reduction in cases referred to MMC
- MMC now does more training and accreditation
- We have trained
 - Industrial Court Judges
 - University lecturers
 - Local authorities
 - Lawyers, doctors, engineers & other professionals
